

INTERNET ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

GRADES K-2

In order to use the Computer Network and Internet, I need to understand and agree to obey the follow rules. If I do not use the Internet and Network in the right way, my teacher may take away my privilege of using them.

Use Rules

- 1. My teacher wants me to learn about important subjects that I am studying at school. I might need to use the Internet to learn more. I will not use the Internet for any other reason than what my teacher asks. For example, when I am supposed to be looking up something about another country, I should not be searching for a cartoon.
- 2. I am not to bring disks or CDs from home and put them in the computer. The files I create are to be saved into my own folder. If I need to take a file home to keep working, I will as for a virus-free disk to use.
- 3. I will not get into files or folders that are not mine.
- 4. Emails and chat rooms are only available to me when my teacher gives permission or directions to use them. When writing or talk with someone on the Network, I will be polite. I will use words or language that my teacher and parents would want me to use.
- 5. I will always use the computer materials carefully. I will remember food and drink should not be near computers. I will be careful with the mouse, keyboard, headphones and other computer parts. If my computer is not working right, I will tell my teacher and not try to fix it myself.
- 6. My teacher my give me a password. It is a special word that only my teacher and I know. I am not to share it with anybody, not even my friend. Even if my friend cannot remember his or her own password, I will not tell my password. I will ask my teacher for help.

I know that almost anyone I contact is a stranger to me, and that I do not share personal information with strangers no matter how nice they seem to be. I will never send them anything, not even using an envelope and a stamp.
- 2. I will never put a picture of myself or a friend on the Internet without my parent's permission.
- 3. Sometimes I may see a site on the Internet that has words or picture that my parents or teachers would not want me to see. I will not try to find those site, and If I com across one them by accident, I will leave it right away. I will not show it to anyone and I will quietly tell my teacher what happened right away. I will not print or save what I saw.

Legal Stuff

- 1. People on the internet that I talk to or write to cannot see me, so they do not know how old I am or what I look like. I promise to never tell people that I am someone else. I will check with my teacher every time before sending an email to someone new.
- 2. I know that my teachers and other school staff may look at the documents and log files to I visit or create the make sure that I am responsibly using the system.
- 3. I agree not to use the words or picture I see on the Internet site without giving credit to the person who owns the site. I will not copy information from the Internet and give it to my teacher and say it is my own work.
